Internship process

- Student searches for internships. They can use Handshake and other tools can also set up internship appointments with Career Services team.
- Once the student has secured an internship, they fill out the internship request form on <u>Career Services</u>' internships page.
- Internship coordinator starts internship agreement/credit registration paperwork from there online via Adobe Sign now.
- Once all signatures are obtained, the internship coordinator hand registers them into a COM section of CPV 400 internship course.
- Faculty sponsor assigns pass/fail grade at end of semester once student has appraisal submitted and has satisfactorily completed any academic assignments. Usually a bi-weekly journal in Brightspace & an end-of-term reflection paper.

Internship registration deadlines (advertised to students/on our website)

- Full Summer Session or Summer Session I: May 1 | Summer Session II: June 1
- Fall Full Semester or Quarter 1: July 1 | Fall Quarter 2: October 1
- Winter: December 1
- Spring Full Semester or Quarter 3: December 1 | Spring Quarter 4: March 1

Their internship request forms should be submitted by these dates above. I have some flexibility for extenuating circumstances, but I do not share this with students, unless needed. Please advise your students to work to meet these deadlines.

Internship quick facts

- CPV 400 variable, elective credit (students can take up to 16 credits of CPV 400)
 - 3 credits count towards major requirement others can count towards elective credit
- Eligibility requirements: (listed on the internship guide on Career Services' internships page)
 - Students must have completed a minimum of 12 credit hours at SUNY Cortland. Transfer credit does not count toward eligibility.
 - Students must be in good academic standing (no academic probation) with no incomplete coursework when the internship begins.
 - Students must receive credit in the semester they are completing the internship. No retroactive credit will be awarded.
- They must do 40 hours of internship work per credit they want to receive 3-credit internships are 120 hours total over the semester/term. It equals around 8 hours per week during fall/spring or 12 hours/week over the summer.
- Paul currently serves as faculty sponsor for all COM students doing internships
- Depending on the nature of the duties, we may need to get an affiliation agreement in place, which takes time

 Positions that put you in touch with private or sensitive data or with at-risk populations (human resources, hospitals, nursing homes, schools, childcare...) may take 6 weeks to finalize.
- Encourage them to start early!
