A compilation of minigraph volumes narrating the cultural and textual backdrop of characters lesser known but on the cusp of the zeitgeist. Focusing on both supervillains and superheroes, this series bridges the gap between academia and popular culture as an introductory volume that provides a launching pad for further discourse.

Books in this series provide introductory volumes for academics and fans alike by highlighting one specific villain or hero, with the aim to focus on super characters who have not enjoyed as much academic attention as more popular characters.

A key element of the series is the balance between the volumes connecting in form and theme, whilst giving authors room to express themselves. Each book would be titled *So You Think You Know...[insert character title]*? Alongside a subtitle to reflect the author's discussion of the character.

In order to provide a consistent structure across the series, while providing the individual author with the necessary freedom to tailor the book to the subject matter, the structure will contain one personal chapter that can take up to 1/3 of the total word count.
